A room costs between 270 and 400 EUR per month depending on the size. (subject to change) If they rent a room in the dorm, they must be rented for five full months. (Apr − Aug, Oct −Feb). The last rent will not be deducted from the deposit. Deposit + Service fee of €800 but must be paid in full. The deposit (€750) will be refunded separately.
	Off-campus housing	The following newspapers might be helpful for your house hunting in and around Weingarten: Schwäbische Zeitung, Der Südfinder. Apart from that you will find accommodation offers (rooms and/or apartments) on the notice boards at University of Education Weingarten and online, www.wg-gesucht.de . Please note that shared apartments are difficult to find due to the number of students in the region. We strongly recommend the dorm rooms.
	Campus dining options	There is a cafeteria as well as a dining hall available on campus. In the dining hall, you can calculate around €2.50 - €4 EUR per meal. The cafeteria and dining hall are closed evenings / holidays / semester breaks.

Finances	Opening a bank account: Bring along some money to deposit in your new account as well as your tax number from your home country. If you have already opened a blocked account prior to your arrival, then the German bank already has this number.
	Please note that some students must open a blocked account prior to their arrival (see proof of sufficient funds in the amount of €992 Euro per month). These students will receive the necessary information in advance. Please bring all necessary papers.
	Proof of sufficient financial means: Germany has specific requirements for each country concerning proof of sufficient funds. Therefore, please contact the International Office about the necessary documentation needed before you arrive.
Further information for oversees partner institutions	No additional tuition fees at the University of Education Weingarten. There is a small, one-time administrative fee that all students must pay of approx €110.
