Application	<p>Student application deadline :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1st semester / Autumn semester: May 31th - 2nd semester / Spring semester : October 31st <p>Students nominated by their home institution will receive an e-mail with the application process. They will have to send :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Copy of passport or identity card - Photo (JPG or JPEG) - Application form - Learning agreement <p>Acceptance letter will be sent by e-mail.</p>

French language courses	<p>One week of intensive French language course at the beginning of each semester (Welcome week – 2 ECTS)</p> <p>Students can also improve their French skills through a special program offered once a week all year round at the school. These courses are free (2 ECTS)</p>

Accommodation	<p>Crous residence (students residence) : each year, the school has around ten rooms available in a Crous residence close to the school. Students can contact the school if they wish to apply. If they do not obtain a place through the school, students can apply directly to the Crous.</p> <p>Private market : hotels residences or private flats</p>
Insurances	<p>Health insurances :</p> <p>For students from the European Union: student must get the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC).</p> <p>For students outside Europe Union: student can register for free to the French social security : https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr</p> <p>Civil liability insurance is compulsory for all the students. It can be included in health or house insurance.</p>
