### INFORMATION FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Nomination deadlines	First semester/full year: <b>May 01</b> <sup>st</sup> Second semester: <b>October 01</b> <sup>st</sup>
Application deadlines	First semester/full year: <b>May 20<sup>th</sup></b> Second semester: <b>October 20<sup>th</sup></b>
Period of the mobility	We accept students for one semester or the full year. It is preferable for students to stay for one year in order to have the opportunity to take the main characterizing courses, which are annual.

Application process	<ul> <li>Students are nominated by their home institution by May 01<sup>st</sup> or October 01<sup>st</sup>.</li> <li>Once the nomination is sent, students will receive information on which documents to submit in order to apply: <ul> <li>Application form</li> <li>ID</li> <li>Artistic portfolio (at least 10 artworks), pdf format</li> <li>Italian language certificate (not compulsory)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Selection process	A committee of professors will reunite and examine students' portfolios and applications. Students will be accepted depending on the quality of their work and the places available in each department/course. Students will receive an answer within 1 month from the application deadline. In case of a great amount of applications, some may be rejected based on the evaluated quality of the portfolio.
Selected students	Selected students must submit their OLA.
Language requirements	An Italian language course for Erasmus students, A2 level, in October and February, is to be confirmed every year. However, students are strongly recommended to have a basic knowledge of the Italian language before their arrival. All the lessons and exams in the Academy are held in Italian.
Transcript of records	A Transcript of Records will be issued within four weeks after the end of the exchange period.
