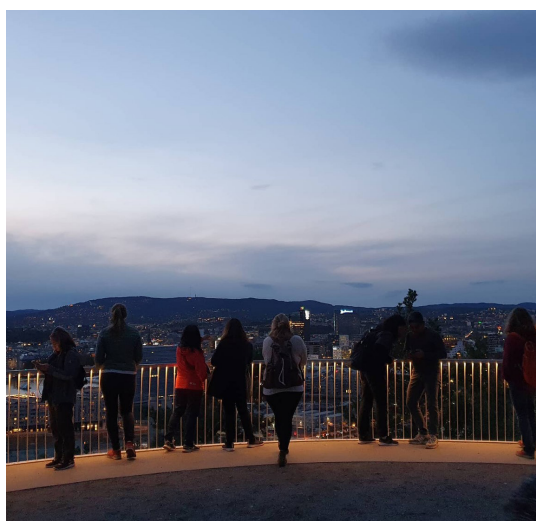

## Cost and Funding

**Tuition Fees:** No tuition for Erasmus students from partner institutions.

**Living Costs:** NOK 11,000–12,000 per month (approx. €1,000–1,100)

This covers accommodation, food, transport, and personal expenses.

## Accommodation

**Student Housing:** Available through SiO (The Student Welfare Organization in Oslo).

**Monthly Rent:** NOK 4,000 – 6,000

Exchange students can apply for housing after acceptance.

## Arrival & Orientation

**Orientation Week:** Provided at the beginning of each semester.

**Buddy Program:** Available to help new students settle in.

## Course Load

**Full-time Study Load:** 30 ECTS per semester

**Typical Course Credit:** 10 ECTS per course
