

SUMMER COURSE

Greetings from Montpellier!

The University Institute for Teaching French as a Foreign Language provides summer courses aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL):

These courses are based on communicative, learning-by-doing methods, with varied teaching materials and targeted socio-cultural content.

- 3 two-week sessions in June and July
- From 40 to 160 hours of lessons (4 hours of lessons per morning, plus 1 or 2 afternoons per week)
- 12 to 20 students (maximum) per group

Integrated activities: Agricultural heritage, olive grove, Wine heritage, Historical heritage, sightseeing in the town of Aigues Mortes ...

Welcome and integration buffet offered at the beginning of each session

Placement test: To determine the student's level, a test is organised upon arrival (for those without DELF/DALF or ADCUEFE Centre diplomas only) for effective integration into French language level groups.

Summer school fees: from 505€ (1 session) which you will have to add 103€ for the student life and campus contribution (CVEC) to be paid before your arrival. This contribution must be paid once no matter the quantity of booking.

Accommodation available in a fully-equipped studio at Ideal Campus near our campus



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Are you running in-person Intensive language courses?

YES. Aprox. 40h per session (1 session = two weeks)

Price: Starting at 505€/session which student has to add 100€ for the student life and campus contribution (CVEC) to be paid by the student on the « CVEC » website. This contribution must be paid once no matter the quantity of booking
