A certificate of attendance with 3 ECTS is delivered at the end of the courses.

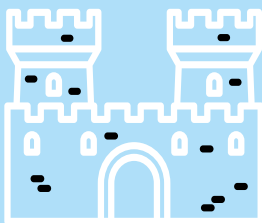
